With this short tutorial you will learn how to easily install the 2-fold or. Top View: The fans are on the inside of the server rack, precisely near the perforated part of the roof panel. This ensures that the warm air is blown out on the shortest path. Buy a Fan Unit for the Wall-mounted Rack This fan is suitable for all our 19-inch wall-mounted racks with depths of 450mm. Get an external PSU 5V/12V sata/molex (looks like a laptop PSU, but with sata/molex out) and an appropriate fan header with sata/molex power input.
