

Where is the best place to connect the fiber optic cable to the router

This port is often labeled and colored differently to indicate it receives the external internet feed.
3. Optimal Placement Place the ONT within 3 meters of the fiber entry point to minimize signal degradation. Both the ONT and router should be near power outlets and in a dry, well-ventilated area. Avoid locations with extreme temperatures, high humidity, or direct sunlight. Keep the router in a central location for better Wi-Fi coverage, but ensure the Ethernet connection from the ONT is short and straight to reduce potential signal loss.
4. Power-Up Sequence Power on the ONT first and wait for its status lights to stabilize, indicating a successful connection to the ISP network. Then power on the router and check that the WAN/Internet light confirms connectivity.
5. Testing Connect a device to the router via Wi-Fi or Ethernet and run a speed test to verify the fiber connection is performing optimally. By following this setup, you ensure that the fiber signal is...
