Adapters can be: Simplex: One connector per side, for single fiber connections. Duplex: Two connectors per side, for bidirectional communication. Quad: Four connectors per side, used in high-density setups. Adapters are installed in the port or panel and may include dust caps or shutters to protect the connection. The internal alignment sleeve ensures precise alignment of fiber cores, maintaining signal integrity.
