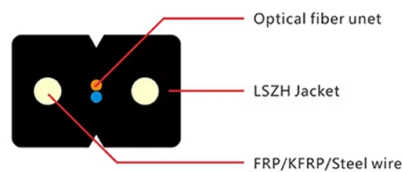


Where should the ground wire of the distribution box be connected

Use the correct wire gauge as specified by local codes (e.g., 10 AWG in the US for certain applications) to maintain low resistance and effective grounding. If the distribution box is metallic, the enclosure itself may also be bonded to the PE bar for additional safety. The metal box itself should be processed with a "box grounding bolt" (with PE mark), which must be connected to the grounded PE bus with a copper core wire or a special braided soft wire;
