- Environmental Protection:** Keep the ONT away from moisture, dust, and extreme temperatures. Indoor installations are generally preferred for better environmental control.

Optional Enhancements

- Media Closet or Network Rack:** If you have a dedicated media closet, placing the ONT there can centralize all networking equipment and improve cable management.
- Backup Power:** Consider a UPS to keep the ONT and router running during short power outages.
