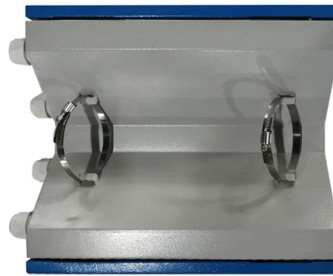


Why are some optical ports on industrial switches unusable
