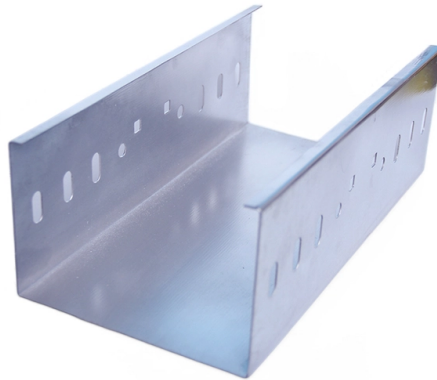


Wiring Requirements for Drilling Distribution Boxes

Ground Wire Size: For US installations, use a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) ground wire; for other markets, a 6 mm² wire is recommended.
