

Wiring method for explosion-proof distribution box switches

General Wiring Principles

Power Isolation: Always turn off the main power supply before wiring to prevent electrocution or sparks.

Grounding: Metal enclosures must be reliably grounded. Connect the grounding wire to the cabinet's outer shell, with a minimum cross-section of 4mm^2 for three-phase systems.

Wiring Switch Types

1P Switch (Single Pole): Only the live wire passes through the switch. The neutral wire must be connected to the neutral bar, while the live wire connects to the switch terminals.

1P+N Switch (Single Pole with Neutral): Both live and neutral wires are connected directly to the switch's input and output terminals, bypassing the neutral bar.

2P Switch (Double Pole): Both live and neutral wires pass through the switch terminals, also bypassing the neutral bar.

Cable Protection and Sealing

Use explosion-proof flexible conduits for exposed wiring. Pass inlet and outlet cables through rubber sealing rings, tightened with washers and compression nuts to maintain the enclosure's integrity. Ensure cables are secure and not loose to prevent sparks or arcing.

Safety and Compliance

Follow national and international standards (IEC, NEC, or local regulations) for hazardous area installations. Verify connections with a multimeter or continuity tester before energizing the system. Only qualified electricians should perform installation and maintenance, especially for high-voltage...
