Securing: Tighten screws or clamps to the manufacturer's specified torque using a torque screwdriver to prevent loose connections and overheating. Verification: Gently tug on each wire to confirm a firm mechanical and electrical connection. Labeling and Organization: Label each terminal and wire for easy identification and future maintenance.
