Incoming Power and Phases For industrial machines like a wire feeding machine, the distribution box typically uses a three-phase system (A, B, C) with a neutral (zero) line and a grounding wire (yellow-green) for safety. The incoming line is usually connected through a three-phase circuit breaker or air switch, with the neutral and ground connected to their respective terminal blocks.

220V single-phase loads: Use one phase line, one neutral, and one ground.

380V three-phase loads: Connect all three phases plus ground; include neutral if local control requires it.

Wiring Layout Inside the Distribution Box

Main circuit breaker to branch breakers: Wiring generally runs on the left side of the box.

Outgoing circuits to equipment: Wiring generally exits on the right side.

Wire binding: Use plastic ties to keep wires straight and organized, with uniform spacing.

Labeling: Clearly mark AC, DC, or voltage levels for each circuit to avoid confusion.

Conductor Selection and Installation Choose copper or aluminum conductors with insulation suitable for industrial environments. Ensure ampacity and voltage drop are calculated based on the machine's power requirements. Use conduits, cable trays, or bus ducts to route wires safely, considering bend radius and support requirements.

Safety and Compliance Include overcurrent protection with circuit breakers or fuses for each branch circuit. Ensure grounding is properly connected to prevent electrical hazards. Follow local electrical codes such as NEC, IEC, or UL standards for industrial panels. Perform a safety inspection after wiring to check for short circuits, overloads, and proper insulation.
