Cable Management: Keep wires neatly organized, avoiding crossing or tangling. Use cable ties, ducts, or channels to separate phase, neutral, and earth conductors. Maintain adequate spacing for heat dissipation and future expansion ().

Breaker Coordination: Ensure that each branch circuit breaker is rated appropriately for its load. The main breaker should have a higher rating than individual branch breakers to provide overall protection ().
